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Non-Admitted Insurance Regulatory Position

Summary

Non-admitted insurance is not permitted because the law provides that insurance must be purchased from locally authorised insurers with some exceptions. It is, however, far from clear what these exceptions are and opinions differ in the market.

Legislation

The legal provisions setting out the requirement for insurers to be authorised are contained in *Article 2 of Law No 20.091* of 11 January 1973 which reads as detailed below.

"Insurance transactions may be realised only by:

- joint stock companies, co-operatives and mutuals
- branches and agencies of foreign insurers of the types mentioned above
- national, provincial or municipal organisms or official bodies.

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Non-Admitted Insurance Regulatory Position

Summary

Update March 2015

Resolution No 38.708 of 6 November 2014 represented a rationalisation and updating of the *General Regulation of Insurance Activity* in line with the government's strategic plan for the industry. It revoked *Resolution No 21.523* of 2 January 1992, the general regulations of insurance activity issued under *Law No 20.091*, and many others which were considered obsolete or have already been superseded. The resolution took effect on 1 December 2014.

Non-admitted insurance is not permitted in Argentina because the law provides that insurance must be purchased from local authorised insurers with no exceptions affecting life, pensions or private medical insurance (PMI).


Legislation

The legal provisions setting out the requirement for insurers to be authorised are contained in *Article 2 of Law No 20.091* of 11 January 1973. The text is as follows:


